

SLATE INSTRUCTIONS:



1. Film in landscape mode as shown in this photo above.
2. Dress is polished casual. Make-up and hair is natural and neat.
3. Make sure you are close to the device to capture good audio and we can see your face in the frame (framing is from top of the head to chest).
4. You should be well lit and against a simple background with little to no background noise.
5. Slate the following:
 - Name, pronouns, agency, height, location base
 - Project: CBT4CBT DRUG REFRESH
 - Role name(s)
 - Indicate your availability for the following dates:
 - May 15, 16, 18 or May 22, 23, 24, 25
6. Full body pic (framed from top of head to toe)
7. Attach your current headshot, updated resume and reels/clips

SELF-TAPE INSTRUCTIONS:

Give us two *different* reads (see audition sides below)

AUDITION SCRIPT: BOBBY

BOBBY is kind of a sleazy, slick guy who deals drugs and while he appears to want to help SAM, he actually is a very bad influence on him.

SCENE: BOBBY walks into a convenience store one afternoon and runs into SAM. They talk for a couple of minutes. BOBBY offers SAM some drugs to help with his pain, and he invites him to a friend's later where there will be drugs, and SAM knows this.

SCREEN DIRECTION: Present lines to camera.

BOBBY:

Hey, man, how's your back?
I told you not to carry that ladder yesterday.

SAM:

Yeah, it's not good. But, what am I gonna do?

BOBBY:

[Gets closer to SAM, conspiratorially] Hey, I got something for your pain.
You got any cash on you?

SAM:

Yeah, I just won 50 bucks!

BOBBY:

Perfect. Your lucky day! Come on, let's go for a ride.

SAM:

[Hesitates, falters a bit] I'm good for now. My kid is coming over later so I've gotta get home.

BOBBY:

[Looking at SAM like "Are you kidding me?"] Seriously? Whatever. I'll be over at Mike's. Give me a shout when your kids gone, and I'll hook you up.

SAM:

I don't know, man. I'll catch you later.
